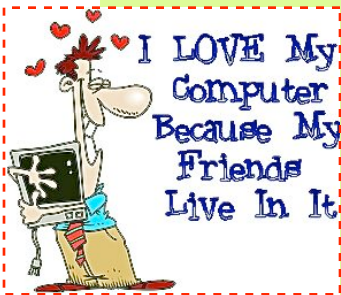
from Latin America-
